# Bold & Feminine

We caught up with our customer Dawn to talk about her home and why she loves painting with bright and bold colours. Dawn is a stay at home mum of 3, and lives with her 2 younger children and husband in their 4 bedroom semi-detached home. They've lived in the home for 18 years, but only recently started really putting their stamp on it over the last 18 months.

"When we first moved in and the kids were young, we prioritised the home being clean and tidy over the design elements" says Dawn. # **DAWN'S TOP 5 DIY TIPS**

- **Preparation** The right tools and preparation are so important when applying paint. If you prep the walls properly and use the right tools, you'll always get a great finish even when doing it yourself.
- Find the right product Do your homework and see what paint will work best for the room, for example when decorating bathrooms, you need a suitable paint that will withstand the environment.
- Have fun! It's so important to make it fun when decorating, whether it's coming up with new exciting projects or being bold with colour.

When we redecorated her bedroom and we both absolutely love this colour. It's a soft, subtle shade of pink and it really lifts the room. We also painted it onto the ceiling in the en-suite which looks really striking!









# PREPARATION

Make sure the wall to be painted is smooth, flake free, dry and clean of grease by wiping it down before you start. Fill any holes if necessary.

# APPLY THE BASE

Apply 1-2 coats of Johnstone's Wall & Ceiling paint in Brilliant White to the walls and ceiling. Depending on the previous colour you are painting, more coats may be required. Leave to dry for 1-2 hours.

# MARK OUT YOUR SECTIONS

Divide your wall into 3 equal sections and mark out each section using masking tape, extending the tape onto the ceiling. Create two smaller sections down either side of the central wall block to form your white stripes.



### ADD YOUR COLOUR BLOCKS

Paint the different sections using the Johnstone's colours of your choice. Here we've used 'Burnt Sugar' from our Wall & Ceiling range for the background colour with Feature Colour 'Maple Haze' as our central colour block. Apply the paint using a roller, using a different roller for each colour. For best results, apply 2 coats, waiting 1-2 hours in between coats.



TIP Remove the masking tape whilst the paint is still tacky to achieve a neat, clean line


